

Sept. 1st 1865,

Dear Husband

One week ago today I wrote you from Rome. Today I am in Oneida Depot at Dr Sporners. They are urgent I should stay untill Mond. I do not know exactly what I shall do yet. The Dr & Lucretia were at Mrs Helloys on Wednesday. She has sold out at Oneida Lake & gone to Clockville. They say Wm will be here after me this week. If he comes I shall go with him & take the cars from Canastota for Syracuse. I had an excellent visit at Rome. Our friends there were very glad to see me. On Tuesday I met Uncle Hellogg, Mr Merrill & Rhoda Hassick & Eliza. Uncle is quite broke down. He is 86 years old. He wanted to be remembered to Mr Ward & wished he could see you. He said he probably never should
